

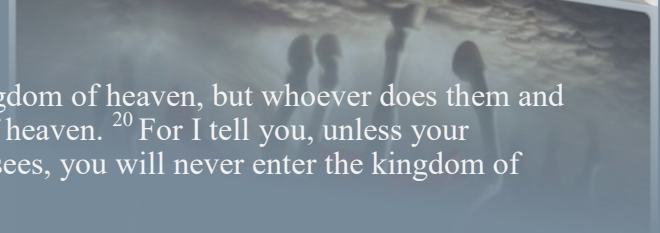

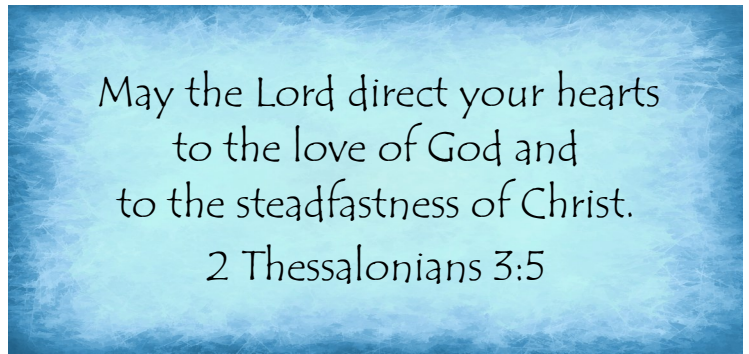
AUGUST 3 - ANNUAL CHURCH FAMILY PICNIC!

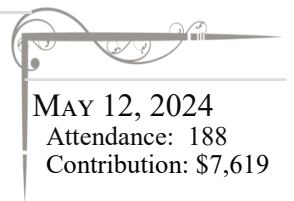

How much does it cost to attend? There is no fee. It’s completely free! Donations are always welcome, but we praise the Lord for blessing us in this ministry.

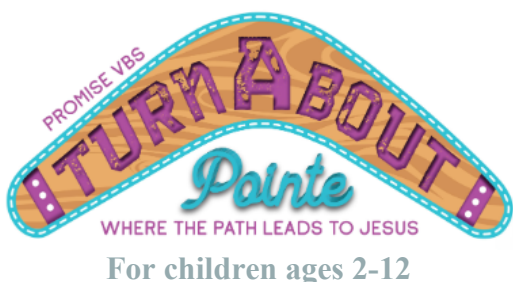
Is it online or in-person? Both! We would love to see all of you in person, but the lessons and keynotes will also be available to view on YouTube.
