

MISSION REPORTS



Hello brethren, family, and friends. We do rejoice and have happiness in our heart over this good news. Just a few days ago we heard from our friends from the Greenbank congregation where we attend while in the states, that one of my contacts from the Methodist Church left them and came one Sunday wanting to place membership! They told her that they needed to further study with her

and that it would be no problem to baptize her once she agreed with the word of God to obey the gospel. I strongly believe on what Acts 17:27 "so that people might seek God, even perhaps grope for him and find him, though indeed he is not far from any one of us." I am praying and looking forward hearing that soon she puts on Christ in baptism.

Since I had to get work on my teeth, I went to the dental clinic I usually go to in Paris. Once I arrived there, I heard that my dentist had retired. They assigned me to a new dental surgeon, a young man between 35 and 40 years old. When he asked me what was my profession, I was exercising I told him 'That I am a preacher for the Church of Christ and explained to him about the Lord's Church' I immediately asked him 'Do you have faith?' He replied, 'I'm a Christian'. I asked him 'Catholic?' His answer was 'Not at all but Evangelical' 'So that means you are interested in studying the Bible?' He replied 'yes'. I simply told him 'That's great it happens that I have something with me that I am sure you would be interested in' It was [Truth for Today]. I will bring him more Bible material that he can read, which I did on my second visit. He gave me his e mail address and phone number, this way I can continue to send him Bible studies. Which I am presently doing.

I contacted Brother Daniel Frerot in Strasbourg. He had to go to the States for his daughter's graduation, but he had no one to take his place for Sunday Worship while in the US. I told him 'That I would be glad to take his place for one Sunday.' He was really happy so Rose and I drove to Strasbourg which took 5 hours 30 minutes. While there we stayed in Daniel's and Tammy's home and visited with sister Gayle, Tammy's Mother. She invited us to go to Burger King. The young man from the Ivory Coast that waited on us was very nice and I jumped on the occasion to talk to him about the Gospel! He attended an Evangelical group in Strasbourg. I told him 'Wonderful that means you like to learn more about God's Word.' His reply was 'yes!' I had several [Truth for Today] in French with me. I gave him one and surprise, another young woman asked me 'If she could I have one?' I asked the young man 'If he would not mind given his name phone number and e mail address?' He did. I informed Daniel about that and give him all the information about that young man, meanwhile I am continuing to send him Bible material.

Since I needed a haircut and was in Paris I went to my usual barber shop. There were two new barbers both from India, the one was Buddhist, and the other one was Evangelical. I quoted to the barber Matthew 4:4 and told him since you are a believer you must be interested in growing spiritually and know more about God's word: he gave me his name and phone number. I send to him a BCC in English.

June 2nd was my birthday, and we were at Sister Francoise Besse's for worship. We had a visitor from Columbia that had been living in Paris for 30 years, she is a friend of Sister Carolina Layton's Mother from Colombia. She had come to worship once before, but we were not present at that time since we were yet in the States at that time. Her name is Claudia Vera. Two cakes were planned for my birthday, she stayed, and I had the opportunity to talk to her

about the Bible. She is interested in learning more; she gave me her email and phone number and I sent her materiel in Spanish since she is not fluent in French. I sent her a DVD in Spanish titled "the Verda" [the truth]. Later I sent her a Bible correspondence course in Spanish that she appreciated

Our daughter Anna called us to go and visit a former Elder of the Church in Delaware that moved to South Carolina, a few years a. [Barry and his wife Nancy Romano] While visiting Paris with his wife and grandson he decided to rent bicycles. In the rain he fell and was taken to the emergency at Bichat the biggest hospital in Paris. Because of the language barrier they took him to the American Hospital in Neuilly. After contacting them the following day, which was June 6th it took me 4 hours and 30 minutes to get to Paris. Normally it takes between 1 hour and 15 minutes and 1 hour and 45 minutes. They were sure happy to see me, while with them I gave precious information about Paris and answered all the questions they had. That evening their son was coming from the states. I enjoyed seeing them again. I let them know not to hesitate to call me if they needed further help.

Brother Franck Delormel and his wife Liva who lives two hours away from Paris now connect to the zoom and participate with us, and for the last 3 weeks Franck have been leading the singing. As last year I have started helping Simon Motaze in Cameroon preparing for this year's Bible camp by sending him teaching material by email and shortly I will also be sending him part of my French Bible library, French Bibles, tracts, Bible DVDs, and Bible correspondence courses for young people and teenagers, communion cups etc. If anyone would like to help with the cost of shipping it would be greatly appreciated.

Brother Francis Nicolas, whom I baptized several years ago while he was in Paris, presently lives and works near Montpellier in South France which makes it difficult for him to go to worship, as the nearest place is 4 hours and 30 minutes away. Since I last contacted him, he joined us through Zoom on Sunday. I am starting a weekly Bible study with him, which he appreciates since up to now he was all by himself. I am staying in contact with all the ones that have I contacted while in the States the last time Rose and I stayed in Delaware for 8 months. July 12th Lord willing I will be flying to Delaware and then in August I will be traveling to Canada, to work with Jean Grenier in Saguenay, helping in the preparation of the annual retreat of the French churches like I did last year, not only I will be preaching but also preparing meals. This time Rose will not be coming with me as she will be staying home in France until my return in October. 13. As requested by Sunset International Bible Institute, I should soon start translating and recording all their class material in French. Just waiting for their signal and requested material.

Loss of support; \$1,500.00 per month. One of our long-time partners in the preaching the gospel in the French world, will terminate our support in the month of August and another one in a few months. Just like last year while in the States every Sunday I continued to preach to our group in Paris by Zoom. Since our return we were happy to see everyone. I am grateful for Brother Mark Kee for helping the group, also brother Michel. We are indeed grateful unto God to all of you who are still involved and continuing to support us spiritually and financially for all these years. We will continue to trust GOD that he will provide.
