I've been encouraging Sister Chimene so pray that I will be able to guide her in her life for Christ. She is doing better and trying to teach her mother now. I am happy to be back in France. I did so enjoy teaching children at Greenbank church of Christ and participating in classes there in Delaware. I've been preparing new lessons to do that again on the next trip I go with Roland. He is leaving July 12 and will be back on Oct 13. Lord willing, I will be able to make the next trip after this time. We are thankful for each prayer and help from those who have been with us in this journey serving the Lord in France, America and other places. Thank you. We have lost some more help. Roland speaks more of this in his letter. I was able to teach American children, some spoke Spanish Jesus loves me in French and they helped me sing it in Spanish. In the new material I don't have it in Spanish yet. Will get the Spanish added to the French and English already prepared. I shared it with Tammy Frerot in Strasboug, France and taught a class while we were there. The children enjoyed and learned. Please pray for my cousin Patti and Sister Ida Partlow and family. Both have pancreatis cancer. My friend Huquette, died with cancer. I miss her. I thank all who have prayed and continue to do so. I pray for so many when I read your bulletins and see the sick. Thank you and I hope you enjoy my letter. I have some flowers like cosmos, morning glory and sweet peas coming up. Lettuce isn't up yet. Our roses are beautiful. We met a new contact and went to visit her and met two other people while there. Her name is Ann and lives about 20 kilometers from us. I had a study with my neighbor Jayne Marie and we are to meet again for another. Her husband is Clement and we have had with Roland, several talks about the Bible in our home. They go to an Evangelical group so pray with me that our studies will lead closer to the truth. We had a visit from Emmanuel and his friend Diana and he was able to help Roland carry in more boxes to pack books for Simon in Cameroon. Emmanuel's friend is Romanian so we learned some more about Romania. There are a lot of Romanians in France. Just want to express my thanks for all the prayers and help for the Lord's work. One of Roland's contacts is studying to know what to do to become a member of the Lord's Church. Thanks for your prayers for all the contacts here and over the world.
