

REPORT FOR THE MONTH 0F AUGUST, 2024 (Tom Ekpot Jr.).

Dear Beloved brethren,

I salute you all in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. On behalf of my family, I appreciate you all for your prayers and for us. For sure God is answering our prayers, otherwise, we would not have been alive today. It is through his grace that He has seen us through the month of August, 2024. We pray the grace given to us during the month of August be extension to us in the month of September. May the God of all Grace continue to grant us access into his presence this month, and help us make the most use of time, knowing that we have a short time to spend here on earth.

Thank you for joining me in prayers for my students. They have all returned to school This year, we have 31 new students. Among them are two foreign nationals (from Chad and Republic of Cameroon respectively). We pray that the session will progress without interruption. Economically, the nation is not good at all as few commodities are being chased by much money in circulation, causing sharp rise in the prices of things. Please, continue to pray for Nigeria. Because of the bad shape of the economy there was ten days protest across the nation that interrupted business activities. It seems that things are even worse now since the protest. The youths are therefore planning for a major protest from the 1st of October. However, as a Bible school, we are to give people hope, not necessarily in this life, but only in Christ. We have therefore resumed our normal door knocking evangelism. We study the Bible with people, persuading them to look beyond here. During the month of the month of August, we studied with 1,530 prospects in different areas in Plateau State. Out of this, the Lord harvested 7 souls into the church. We are hopeful that others will see the despair in the world system and will accept to be saved.

The young congregation that started in Ray Field, Jos is moving on. Located in the midst of big denominations, it becomes difficult for the church to break into the heart people. However, we keep preaching the unadulterated Gospel to people, and God keeps bringing in those who want to be saved. During the month of August, we had one baptism. We have been having visitors come into worship with us. We had our first children's seminar this year. Children from different congregations came around to learn the Bible. It was an exciting moment for the kids. We hope to make it a yearly exercise to teach kids the word of God. We are living in a time many people no longer retain in their heart the love for God and the desire to obey Him. We believe the problem is in the foundation given to children. We may not be able to save all, but we pray

that we will save some by cultivating in them the love for God and desire to doing his will.

We did not extend the invitation for children outside Jos town because of the space we have in the building.



Being rainy season, it was difficult to use tent outside either. We still appreciate God for what we have. It was the first one for this new

congregation; we hope to improve in the planning in the subsequent one. Sandra is very helpful in this children's ministry. She loves kids and know how to motivate their interest for God. Being a teacher in the children's class for a long time gives her experiences that I do not have in handling children. She is a valuable tool in this ministry. Sandra is also coordinating women class in the congregation. It is interesting that women from other congregations are now joining our women Bible class on Tuesday.

Let me use this opportunity to appreciate you all for your sacrificial giving and prayers for us. I pray that our Good God will meet each and every one of you in His special way. May He supply your needs according to his riches in glory. I am one of those appointed by the School of Biblical Studies, Jos, to be in the States during some part September and October to help raise fund for the running of the School in the Northern Nigeria. So, most of the weeks in September and October, I will not be around in Nigeria. But I know by the grace of God, the work of saving souls, knocking doors and edifying the brethren in Jos will continue. Keep me in your prayers. Wishing you a happy September 2024.
